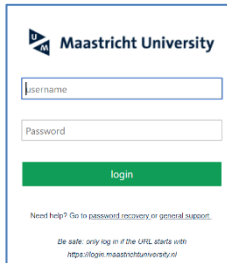
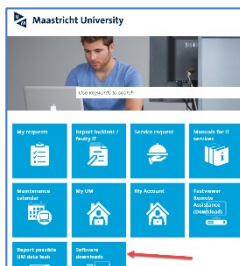


Installing EndNote on your mac for home use

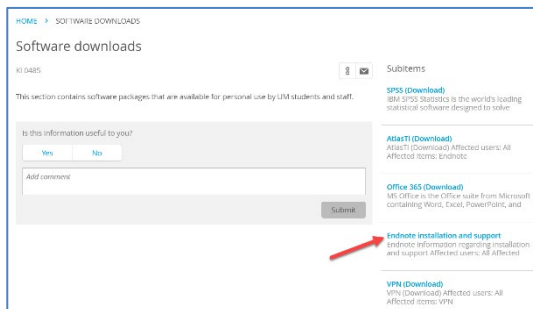
- Surf to the [ICT Self Service Portal](#) and enter your UM username and password to get access to the software.



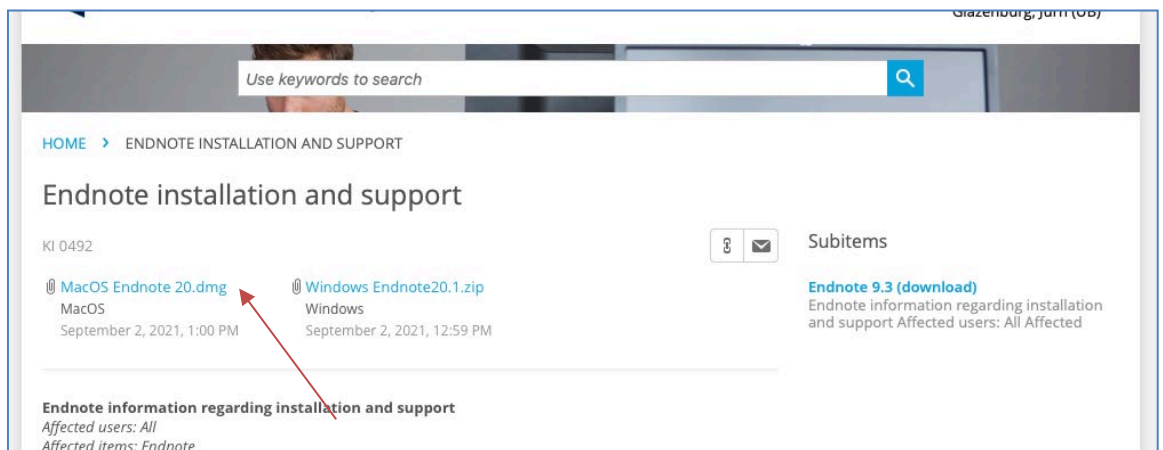
- Click on the button 'software downloads'.



- At the right side of the software downloads webpage click the link to the EndNote page.



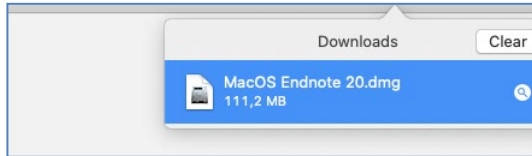
- Click the .dmg file to download it to the download folder.



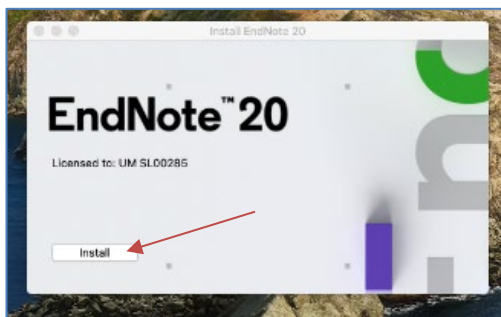
- Click once to open the download folder



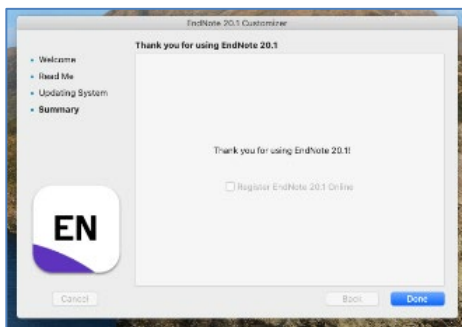
- Double click the downloaded .dmg file to open the Endnote installer.



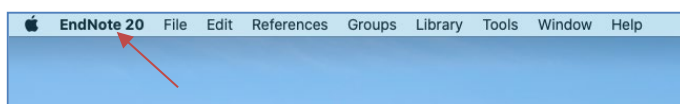
- Double click the EndNote install button to install it in the Applications folder. A product key should not be necessary.



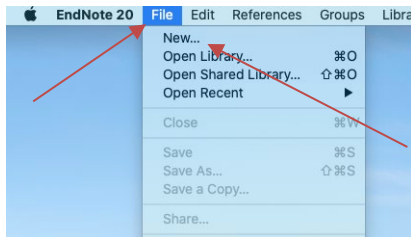
- Click through a few installation/settings screens.
- After clicking 'done' it may look that nothing happened.



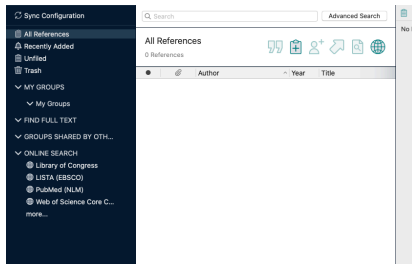
- Check in the top menu-bar to make sure EndNote 20 is activated. In the Dock the EndNote icon should have a little triangle underneath.



- Click 'file' and 'New' to open a new library. Name it and 'save' it on your Mac. Never save EndNote libraries on network drives or cloud-syncing folders (like OneDrive, SurfDrive, Dropbox, Google Drive, or iCloud). This may cause data corruption and eventually loss of data.



- Your library is ready for use. In full screen mode, the top menu-bar disappears from view. Move your mouse to the top of the screen to use it.



- If you resize the EndNote library window the top menu bar will stay visible.
